



Cookies Policy

“Cookies” (or web, internet, or browser cookie) are small pieces of data or information stored on the user’s computer or device by your web browser while using a website. They enable the website or service provider to recognize our browser and to capture and remember certain information. They also help us to understand your preferences based on your previous or current browsing activity, which in turn helps us improve our services to you.

We use cookies on our website to:

- Understand and save the user’s preferences for future visits, and
- Compile aggregate data about site traffic and site interactions in order to offer better site experiences and tools in the future. We may also use trusted third-party services that track this information on our behalf.

You, the user, can elect to be prompted prior to each time you use cookies on our website (in which case you will need to agree or disagree to their use that that time), or you can disable cookies altogether. This can be done in your internet browser settings. If you choose to disable all cookies, some services on our website may not function properly and other features may be disabled.
